Thank you for volunteering to judge Calf Club NZ. This competition could not happen without your generous support.

We have prepared this basic info sheet so that you are aware of how Calf Club NZ runs and we ask that you all cast your eyes over it and let us know if you have any questions.

# Judging 1st October to 16th October

All formal judging this year will take place in the 3rd school holidays beginning on the 1st of October and ending on the 16th of October.

You will be assigned with a list of contestants on the **15th of September** and it ill be your job to make contact and book a time to visit and judge each contestant.

All results will need to be digitally input for each contestant by **4pm the 17th of October no exceptions** as results are being published in the November Dairy Farming Magazine.





We have a set of standardised rules and regulations we use to judge each contestant. Please find this document attached.

You will need to familiarise yourself with this before judging your contestants this year.

**Note:** All bull calves are to be judged as beef for conformation, regardless of breed.

#### **Photos**

We love to see photos of judging day. If you are happy to have your photo taken we encourage you to prompt parents to take photos of the action and send them to the Calf Club NZ Facebook page.

#### What to Bring

We recommend bringing 7 standards with you to quickly set up leading ring markers in case the contestant does not have an appropriate leading ring set up. A rope is not necessary.

#### **Dress Code & Branded Vehicles**

Avoiding conflicts of interest all judges must avoid wearing clothing or driving vehicles branded in any Al Company or Breed Societies branding.

Every effort is being made to ensure Calf Club NZ is a neutral competition.

We prefer to stick with trained judges, we can however get you placed with one of our judges as an assistant to learn from.

## Scorecards & Results



The supplied Calf Club NZ scorecard should be used with each participant to assign points for each aspect.

Scorecards are the best way for you to keep track of each contestant and are also used to calculate our Nation Wide Placings across the entire event.

Once you have judged all of your area contestants you will need to populate their results into Calf Club NZ's scorecard collection form.

When submitting your scorecard results we will also request you submit a final decision placing for your contestants.

All results must be submitted by **4pm on the 17th of October** with no exception. This hard deadline is to ensure results are published in the November Dairy Farmer magazine.
